ARGUMENTS ON SAN FRANCISCO BAY RESTORATION
AUTHORITY PARCEL TAX MEASURE AA TO BE VOTED ON AT THE
CONSOLIDATED PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON JUNE 7, 2016**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified Napa County electors of the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority (Authority) that in accordance with the provisions of the California Government Code and the California Elections Code, a Parcel Tax election will be consolidated with the Tuesday, June 7, 2016. Primary Election for the Measure shown below. Polling hours will be from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM on June 7, 2016. Central counting for Napa County will be conducted at 900 Coombs Street Room 256, Napa, CA

MEASURE AA

San Francisco Bay Clean Water, Pollution Prevention and Habitat Restoration Program.

"To protect San Francisco Bay for future generations by reducing trash, pollution and harmful toxins, improving water quality, restoring habitat for fish, birds, and wildlife, protecting communities from floods, and increasing shoreline public access, shall the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority authorize a parcel tax of \$12 per year, raising approximately \$25 million annually for twenty years with independent citizen oversight, audits, and all funds staying local?"

NOTICE is further given that pursuant to the Elections Code of the State of California, the Governing Body of the Authority, or any members thereof authorized by such body, or any individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of such voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length for or against said measure.

NOTICE is further given that based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for said election, the Elections Division has fixed 5:00 PM on Tuesday March 15, 2016 as a reasonable date after which no arguments for or against Measure AA may be submitted for printing and distribution to voters. Arguments must be submitted to the Napa County Election Division 900 Coombs Street Room 256 Napa, California 94559. Arguments may be withdrawn or changed up to and including the time and date set forth as the deadline for filing. If arguments are submitted both for and against Measure AA, the authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The Election Division has fixed 5:00 PM Tuesday, March 22, 2016 as the deadline for submission of rebuttals if any.
