**Public Notice of Election, Ballot Arguments, and Central Count:
San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority Parcel Tax Measure AA**

Notice of Election

Notice is hereby given to the qualified San Francisco electors of the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority (Authority) that, in accordance with the provisions of the California Government Code and the California Elections Code, a parcel tax election for the measure shown below will be consolidated with the Tuesday, June 7, 2016, Presidential Primary Election. Polling places will be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on June 7.

AA:

San Francisco Bay Clean Water, Pollution Prevention and Habitat Restoration Program.

"To protect San Francisco Bay for future generations by reducing trash, pollution and harmful toxins, improving water quality, restoring habitat for fish, birds, and wildlife, protecting communities from floods, and increasing shoreline public access, shall the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority authorize a parcel tax of \$12 per year, raising approximately \$25 million annually for twenty years with independent citizen oversight, audits, and all funds staying local?"

Notice of Ballot Arguments

Notice is further given that, the Authority will designate authors for the proponent argument to appear in the San Francisco Voter Information Pamphlet. Any individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of such voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, against this measure, to appear in the San Francisco Voter Information Pamphlet. If arguments are submitted both for and against Measure AA, the authors may prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not to exceed 250 words. The submission deadlines are as follows:

- Proponent or Opponent Arguments – 5 p.m. on Thursday, March 17
- Rebuttals to Proponent or Opponent Arguments - 5 p.m. on Monday, March 21
