Governing Board

- Adopts grant program guidelines and awards grants at public meetings.
- Appointed by the Association of Bay Area Governments.

Advisory Committee

- Assists and advises
 Governing Board; reviews
 and comments on annual
 reports.
- Appointed by the Governing Board.

Oversight Committee

- Reviews audits, expenditures, and financial reports; publishes an annual report of its findings.
- Appointed by the Governing Board.

Process that the Authority uses to Solicit Applications, Evaluate Proposals, and Award Grants

- Staff proposes updates RFP and grant application form.
- Solicitation is at least once a year.

RFP (Authority Staff)

RFP (Advisory Committee)

 Advisory Committee reviews proposed changes to RFP and grant application form. Governing Board reviews RFP and application form; considers and adopts at a public meeting.

RFP (Governing Board)

Screening (Authority Staff)

•Staff screens proposals for eligibility based on Restoration Act and Measure AA and CEQA readiness.

 Review by at least three professionals; may include Authority Staff and Advisory Committee Members.

> Review (Staff, Advisory, and Professionals)

Recommendation (Authority Staff)

 Staff recommends projects to board based on prioritization criteria, pool of proposals, funds available, urgency and readiness. Governing Board reviews, considers, and approves projects at a public meeting.

> Award (Governing Board)

Controls Oversight

(Oversight Committee)

- Annually reviews conformance with Measure AA.
- Reviews audits and expenditure and financial reports.
- Publishes an annual report of findings.
