\*Note on shellfish and subtidal habitat: The SF Bay Subtidal Habitat Goals document provides the necessary background that should be used when quantifying subtidal performance measures. Subtidal habitat components (such as the installation of reef balls) are often small in size, however provide a large host of indirect and direct habitat benefits. A 1:5, 1:10, 1:25, or even 1:100 conversion from the net footprint of reef balls area can be used depending on the project components.
